



Internships

- As part of the 'ladder' of work experience / career development opportunities we're offering as part of STEP UP, we've decided to extend the range of internships available with the company – longer term (4-26 weeks), professional level attachments, working alongside our creative/management team on a specific project, usually resident at our Nottingham office/rehearsal base and/or on a regional/national tour.
- Interns agree key learning objectives with a New Perspectives mentor at the start of their time with the company and review approach/progress at regular intervals during the project PLUS benefit from on-going 'helpline' support after their internship.
- Thanks to the financial support of East Midlands Airport, internships are offered FREE.
- We also have a modest budget to support some interns' travel/accommodation costs.

Eligibility

- STEP UP is open to anyone aged 18-25 years living, working or studying in the East Midlands (Derbyshire, Leicestershire, Lincolnshire, Northamptonshire, Nottinghamshire & Rutland).
- STEP UP Internships are aimed at young/emerging theatre-makers who have already undertaken some higher level / vocational training and are at 'point of entry' into a theatre career.
- We therefore also welcome Internship applications from mature students/graduates.

Application / Selection Process

- We accept Internship applications at any time of year and aim to get back in touch with applicants within four weeks of receipt.
- However, we require that applications are submitted at least eight weeks prior to the start of the period of an applicant's availability to undertake an internship, and advise that, where possible, applicants apply much earlier, since our project/production plans tend to be drawn up at least a year in advance – we will usually consider Internship applications up to twelve months in advance of the requested period.
- Where we feel that we may be able to offer suitable internships, applicants will be invited to attend an interview to discuss their application further.
- Successful applicants will receive a written Internship offer outlining dates/project/mentor and other practical information relating to the internship.
